## COLD CREEK CONSERVATION AREA HOSTS 22<sup>nd</sup> ANNUAL FEAST OF FIELDS

KING TOWNSHIP-Organic Advocates, Feast of Fields announced they will be returning to Cold Creek Conservation Area to celebrate the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Feast of Fields with a 5 year location commitment underway.

"We are delighted to be returning to Cold Creek and that our 5 year location commitment has been finalized. The location was a hit last year and we couldn't be happier to know it will be our home for the next five." In conjunction with support from King Township, we will be working together to help build a permanent pavilion on-site as a legacy for the benefit of all future park users. Construction on the Pavilion is set to start this year and be unveiled at the Sept. 11<sup>th</sup> event.

Each year net profits help fund community programs and for the next five the monies will be going towards the permanent pavilion.
